The foreign currency – in this declaration – is the non-Egyptian currency, and in the event of not declaring it or not declaring the Bearer Negotiable instruments and securities or submitting incorrect data regarding them, the violator will fall under penalty of law in accordance with the provisions of Articles (12, 14 repeated-1) of the Anti-Money Laundering Law issued by Law No. 80 of 2002, in addition to Articles (213), and (233) of the Central Bank, Banking System and Monetary Law issued by Law No. 194 of 2020, and the provisions of the customs law issued by Law no. 207 of 2020.

The non-Egyptian arrival must obtain a certified copy of the form prepared for the purpose of the amounts or the bearer negotiable instruments or their total together, that exceeds ten thousand US dollars or its equivalent in other foreign currencies, as non-Egyptians are allowed upon departure to carry the remaining amounts of money that has been disclosed on the form.

The limit of exemption from customs tax for the personal belongings of the arrivals is of a value of ten thousand Egyptian pounds of new items intended for personal use, provided that they do not have a commercial status.

Any of the following products shall be declared (agricultural – animal - birds – marine – medical devices and supplies – pharmaceuticals and medicines – cosmetics – valuable items – works of any precious metal other items that exceed the prescribed personal exemption limit other than used personal items).

Non declaring the items accompanying the passenger will place the bearer under the penalty of the customs Law and the other related laws.
